
KEY TRENDS AND STATISTICS:

The data is collected from Statistics Estonia, Positium LBS, Tallinn Airport and Port of Tallinn.


Visits to Tallinn by foreign residents

According to mobile positioning data **3,607,399 foreign visitors** visited Tallinn in January - September 2017 of which **same-day visits 2,206,058** and **overnight visits 1,401,341**. 1,145,155 international tourists stayed at Tallinn's accommodation establishments.

Length of the trip

According to mobile positioning data there were 2,202,665 same-day visitors to Tallinn. Multi-day visits had the average duration of 2.85 days.

The longest overnight trips were made by visitors from Angola – 5.30 days The shortest overnight trips were made by visitors from Uruguay - 2.14 days.

Accommodated tourists in Tallinn

According to Statistics Estonia, 1,320,460 tourists stayed in accommodation establishments in Tallinn (a +4% change compared to the same period last year).


Total number of accommodated tourists: 1,320,460 (+4% +45,922 people) Incl.:

- domestic tourists: 175, 305 (+12% +18,741 people)


International tourists accounted for 87% and domestic tourists for 13% of the total number of tourists.





Overnight stays of tourists accommodated in Tallinn


According to Statistics Estonia, in January - September 2017, **tourists spent 2,366,570 nights in Tallinn's accommodation establishments** (+4% compared to the same period last year).

Overnight stays in total: 2,366,570 4% +87,418 nights


Incl.:

- overnight stays by international tourists: 2,061,443 (+2%, +43,886 nights)
- overnight stays by domestic tourists: 305,127 (+ 17%, +43,532 nights)


The overnight stays of international tourists accounted for 87% and the overnight stays of domestic tourists for 13% of all overnight stays of tourists.

Overnight stays of accommodated international tourists in Tallinn, January - September 2017





Tourists are divided into three categories according to the purpose of their trip: holiday; business; and other purposes. Business trips are in turn divided into conference tourism and business tourism.


Purposes of travel of visitors to Tallinn, January - September 2017

Domestic and international tourists in accommodation establishments in Tallinn by purpose of travel.





Length of stay of tourists

The tourists average length of the trip was 1.79 nights (0% compared to the same period last year).


Domestic tourists spent an average of 1.74 nights, which is 4.33% compared to the same period last year. International tourists spent an average of 1.80 nights, which is -0.56% compared to the same period last year.

In January - September 2017, from the main external markets, visitors from United Kingdom stayed the longest – 2.20 nights on average. Visitors from Finland stayed the shortest, spending 1.53 nights on average in Tallinn's accommodation establishments.




Occupancy of rooms in accommodation establishments

The average occupancy rate of rooms in accommodation establishments in Tallinn in January - September 2017 was 66% (0.44% compared to the same period last year.). The average cost for 24 hours was 47 euros (10.78% compared to the same period last year.).



Air passengers in Tallinn Airport

In January - September 2017, Tallinn Airport served 1,998,767 passengers (18,2% in comparison to the same period last year).



Passengers in Tallinn Old City Harbour

In January - September 2017 8,208,658 passengers passed through Tallinn Old City Harbour (+4% compared to the same period last year).
